

The Birth of Harmon's John

 The Knickerbocker families in Connecticut included a man who was called "Harmon's John"




- Harmon's John lived in Sharon in 1799
 - Land records show that John Knickerbocker "of Sharon" sold his rights to 36 acres of land that were left intestate by his grandfather
 - The deed was dated in 1799, and was recorded in 1800.
- The 1800 census in Sharon shows John, a wife, 5 boys, and 2 girls.
 - The 1800 census entries exactly match the family that later lived in Eaton, New York.
- In 1804, John and his wife Lydia bought land in the "Second Township" in "Hamilton, Chenango County" (which later became the town of Eaton in Madison County).
 - John and Lydia were married in 1785, in Sharon.
- New York records show that John was born in about 1760 or 1761.
 - Census records give John's age as 89 in 1850, and 94 in in 1855.
 - John's tombstone, in January of 1860, said he was in his 100th year.
- We have finally found the original birth record in Connecticut.
 It confirms that John was born in 1760.

For a small fee, the Salisbury clerk would reserve space in the town record for a given family.

Here, for example, the Towsley family reserved the top of this page, and eventually used it to record the successive births of 3 children.

On this page, the Towsleys were the only family who recorded multiple births. For example, the births of John Knickerbocker's younger siblings were not recorded anywhere in town records.



Harmon Knickerbocker born January 13, 1742

During colonial times "January 1741/2" indicated the January that occurred during the winter between '41 and '42. Today, we write this as "January 1742". Abraham & Jon of John Knicker backer of Jamima his wife was Born April of 12th 1733

Lawrance of John Knicker backer & Jamima his wife was Born January & 13th 1741/2

Mary & Doughter of John Knicker backer & Jamima his wife was Born December & 18th 1741/2

Jone the Doughter of John Knicker backer & Jamima his wife was Born December & 18th 1744

Jone the Doughter of John Knicker backer & Jamima his wife was Born August & 6th 1747

Isoa & Jon of John Knicker backer & Jamima his wife was Born June & 17th 1750

These entries appear in the section of the town records from the early 1750's. It appears these births were entered into Salisbury records in 1752, after Sarah was born. (There are many examples in the town record where a family waited many years, and then recorded the births of all their children in a single transaction with the town clerk.)

Thus, Harmon's birth wasn't recorded until 10 years after he was born. This 10 year delay might cause us to question whether this record is reliable. However, the date is confirmed by a separate baptism record.

Harmon was only age 17 years and 11 months when his son John was conceived.

Baptisms were done by a travelling minister. The baptisms were eventually recorded at a church in Greene County, New York. The church records were later transcribed and published in multiple places, including the NYGBR article shown above. This multi-step process might cause us to worry about transcriptions errors. However, the date of Harmon's birth shown here – January 13, 1742 – exactly matches the entry in Salisbury town record.

In his articles on the Knickerbocker Family, William Van Alstyne claimed the baptism record showed the birth as January 3^{rd} , instead of January 13^{th} . In any case, though, everyone agrees the year was 1742.
